

# HAYS CITY SPORTSMAN CLUB

## Monday Evening Trap League Rules

1. Practice rounds may be shot prior to league start time. Each round costs \$3.50 per person. Please purchase your practice tickets ahead of time in the clubhouse. Practice rounds must be purchased to keep league entry fees at a minimum.
2. League shooting will begin promptly at 6:30 p.m. each Monday evening. No team is allowed to shoot their league rounds earlier than the scheduled start time. Clipboards will not be handed out early.
3. On an experimental basis we will be using a new system for figuring handicaps. The first week all teams will shoot from the 16 and 20 yard lines. After that, team handicaps will be figured on the team's average from the prior week on the 16 yard line plus two yards. Ex. - if the team averages 23 hits from the 16 yard line, they will shoot their handicap from the 25 yard line. Handicaps can change from week to week. No team handicap will be shot from less than the 20 yard line and no farther back than the 27 yard line.
4. No substitute shooters will be allowed. If a shooter begins the year and then has to drop out, that person's average targets will be used for team totals. If teams or individuals cannot shoot the last week of league their average targets will be used.
5. Any team that begins the league with less than a full squad may add a shooter as long as the shooter is not on another team; fees are paid; and all make up rounds are completed by the end of the third week of league. This must be completed by the end of the third week for classification purposes.
6. Individual scores will be posted on the bulletin board in the clubhouse and on the website at [www.shoothcsc.com](http://www.shoothcsc.com). Team scores and rankings will not be posted until the teams have been classified after week 3.
7. If all or part of your team is present, you must shoot. You can check the website at [www.shoothcsc.com](http://www.shoothcsc.com) for postponements due to the weather. If teams are already assembled at the club and inclement weather occurs prior to shooting, teams must vote on whether to shoot or not and the majority will rule. Shooting will be stopped if it is unsafe to continue, ex. lightning or heavy rain, etc.
8. A full squad must be maintained to win trophies.
9. A shooter is allowed only two make up rounds to be considered for the individual trophies.
10. Individuals can shoot their make up rounds during or prior to the start of league shooting. Makeup rounds can be shot from the assigned traps until league starts at 6:30 p.m. After that they will be shot on the practice trap. Make up rounds for the first week will be shot from the 16 and 20 yard lines. Any make up rounds shot after that will be shot from the 16 yard line and two yards will be added to that score to determine the handicap round.
11. **EACH TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP THEIR EMPTY SHELLS.** Any help with scoring and loading the trap house is appreciated.
12. Teams should rotate shooting positions each week so that the same team is not always the last or first to shoot. Give consideration to young shooters and those who travel a long distance.
13. At least one team member must be present to accept the team trophies on the final night.
